- Students will not hang on the Barres or touch the mirrors. Any mirror or barre broken by a student as a result of misbehavior will be replaced at the family's expense. Please review expected behavior with your child.
- The studio is not responsible for any lost or stolen items. Please leave all valuables at home.
- Please leave all jewelry at home. For safety reasons, no jewelry may be worn in class.
- It is important that students come to class dressed in the proper dance attire as outlined in "What to Wear". This is important so body lines are easily seen by the instructor. This is also necessary for proper instruction and greater progress.
